# **UDP Strategic Planning Discussion**

During the last strategic planning workshop there were 9 areas of focus that emerged:

- 1. Governance/Administration
- 2. Program/Curriculum
- 3. Research
- 4. Productivity
- 5. Students
- 6. Partnerships
- 7. Service/Contribution
- 8. Visibility/Reputation
- 9. Funding/Resources

There are two ways to move forward with the strategic plan:

- 1.We address these 9 areas in any sequence and move forward addressing each at the faculty meetings...moving forward
- 2. Focus on the previous strategic plan, which would involve looking backward and also reworking it to fit our existing community

## Discussion

- Ann votes to move ahead for the future and go with option number 1
- Jan thinks discussions are exciting and thinks retrofitting old plan is cumbersome
- · Moving forward, what will be participation be like?
- Branden would work with Kelly and ask for input while addressing the 9 items.
- Chris is excited with the concept of using a portion of the faculty meeting to address each of the 9 areas



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- Could the faculty meeting be extended by half an hour?
- Bob suggests we try it winter quarter
- Christine...could we have a time line for the strategic plan?
- Branden moves forward with option number 1 and we will focus on these 9 areas per the last strategic plan meeting. For this first meeting we will focus on governance

#### Governance:

- Governance and Admin have been linked but for the time being, lets separate
- Faculty meeting for example. Show up and be present, put your computer away, don't have side conversations
- How do we want to behave?
- How do we want to work collectively?
- How do we want to be held accountable?
- Branden notes the CEP students have a student contract of how to behave and govern themselves, maybe our faculty could have a similar faculty contract...written or implied?

# Conversation:

- Marina: How does technology affect the perception of what one is doing....She is very supportive of a 'contract" but suggests it includes allowance for rule "bending" for certain situations..ie using computers
- Jan W: Like the idea and notion of working collectively...Jan was inspired to work on a large
  grant by the other faculty and their shared interest and their request for her
  participation...because of that it fostered interdisciplinary work. She is wanting to see us be
  more forward in working collectively for example in research and potentially curriculum
  development
- Branden: Agrees with Jan and thinks as an example, our newest faculty Himanshu has been really brought into the fold by getting on grant proposals etc.
- Dan A: we're not a large group...individuality is also important to our group as a whole. Doesn't understand if we're not already self-governing...how would that change? Dan also remembers in the last meeting that the group as a whole spoke the more about visibility then governance.
- Branden counters that as a group, the faculty and admin have been moving forward with good procedural behavior
- Christopher asks? Do you think we do a good job self-governing?



### Jan 13 2015

- Dan A...again...thinks we need to focus more on visibility rather then governance
- Bob M Thinks it's hard to think of abstractly
- Phil Hurvitz thinks we are all respectful of one another
- Christine suggests a suggestion box? Some way to drop an anonymous idea?
- Himanshu: might be a good idea to have a planning page for new faculty? What are the committees?

Discussion concludes and it's agreed the faculty will discuss another one of the 9 areas at the next meeting.
