Movement toward online evaluations

Main concern is that people have experience with drop off rates

3 years ago they changed the way people submitted evaluations Currently course evaluations are online.

Over the three years they have focused on different aspects of the online evaluations.

The first year they highlighted student survey part

The second year admin roles are greater

Third year they worked with the law school and that program is now is totally online

The online forms are the same that you've seen on paper.

A URL is sent to students

Faculty interface to look at results and add anything...

Faculty can order themselves but it's a bit old

Departmental admins can order for instructors

The college would make the decision whether or not comments are seen.

Students tend to respond more if its on a laptop

Mobile responses unknown

Online responses are much more varied...

Other colleges experience is varied...every dept. has it's own culture.
