Discussion of Sofia Dermisi joint appointment

67% would reside in RE

MOU presented

Sofia: "The reason I'm interested is the need to break down the silos...I would be the person to bridge the current silos that exist. There are a number of MUPs that are interested in RE and it would be good to be there to discuss RE and in addition I could serve on thesis committee.

It's a good idea to keep the communication going on with both departments. It would be good to have collaboration with RE and UDP in terms of research. It would be good to start thinking about joint studios."

This is stronger than an adjunct...we have 33% of her participation.

Discussion of departmental decision-making
