Approval of May 31 meeting minutes Jan, Dan, 6 Yes, 0 Abstain

Teaching Faculty Hire: postpone hire until the fire (don't even have sufficient faculty available to today to fully discuss); make a decision in Autumn;

- Jan: what's the application deadline?
- Christopher: yesterday (6/6/22)
- Jan: we should reopen it to see if we can get an larger/better applicant pool (Christopher agreed)
- Christopher: as a result of postponing this decision (which was agreed by group verbally), we're short instructors for the following courses: CEP 200, 446, 490, 564
- Dan: 564 (working with Manish, who's on leave, to revise way course is offered); Jan: we can't offer it that way next year because there's no time to get the change approved
- Christopher's proposal: we can hire Keith Harris as a Teaching Associate (not sure if he'd take the job); FT Autumn appointment to teach these courses; we can't hire him on a long-term basis any longer, but HR allows for short-term hires on quarter-by-quarter basis (to ensure departments can cover instead of cancel courses); this buys time to conduct a national search for a Teaching Associate Professor, who can start in Winter 2023; this is a stop-gap solution to cover fall needs

- Christine suggested hiring Peter Dunn as a one-quarter Teaching Associate (she thought several graduating PhD students might be great fit); Christopher indicated Peter Dunn isn't available this fall and that some of these courses (e.g. CEP 200) are difficult to teach
- Jan felt difficulty wasn't as relevant as fit with PhD research focus; Sofia and Christopher pushed back as an untried teacher for an introductory course (from which many major applicants are drawn) can be highly disruptive; Christopher also uncomfortable with introducing an untried instructor to MUP course (UDP 564)
- Dan moved to offer Keith Harris a Teaching Associate position for Autumn 2022; Sofia seconded
 Results: 7 Yes, 1 No
- Dan moved to offer Katherine Idziorek an Affiliate Assistant Professor appointment; Sofia seconded
